At least a **3.0 Cumulative GPA**



At least a **3.0 Major GPA**  
(Its okay to join if you haven't started with your major subjects yet)



Required to serve **25 hours** per semester



**10 Hours** professional Meetings (Firms meetings) – **5 meetings**



**10 Hours** Service/Volunteer (**tutoring**, community service)



**5 Hours** of your choice (between the 2)



**\$125 joining Fee** (75\$ initiation, 50\$ per semester after).
